Healthy and unhealthy food

What we drink and what we eat is very important. What we put in our body affects our mood, our physical abilities, our heart, our entire body and our health in general.

We should prefer to eat **healthy** food. That is, food that do not have a lot of fat and that are natural. But there are also unhealthy food like:


- > fried food: sausages, fries, hamburger


Bia's Family
